



Holy Week and Easter Services at St. Andrew's



- 8:00 a.m. **Passion Sunday with Liturgy of the Palms: April 17**
10:00 a.m. *With the blessing of the palms (and procession at 10 am), our morning services at 8 and 10 am move from the triumph of the palms to the pain of the cross.*
- 7:00 p.m. *At 7 pm, the ALT. Worship team will lead a meditative service using the music of Taize, prayer, scripture and silence.*
- 7:30 p.m. **Holy Monday, April 18**
A simple, said communion service at 7:30 pm with reflection on Jesus's last week.
- 7:30 p.m. **Holy Tuesday, April 19**
The Stations of the Cross are walked at 7:30 pm, reminding us of Christ's last moments through readings and prayer.
- 10:00 a.m. **Holy Wednesday, April 20**
Our regular 10 am Wednesday service focuses on Jesus's last days.
- 7:30 p.m. *The Service of Tenebrae starts at 7:30 pm as we remember the words of the prophets foretelling what is to come and the church grows darker and darker.*
- 7:30 p.m. **Maundy Thursday, April 21**
We mark Jesus's Last Supper at 7:30 pm, with the footwashing, and then recall how his disciples abandoned him alone in the Garden of Gethsemane.
- 10:00 a.m. **Good Friday, April 22**
The Celebration of our Lord's Passion begins at 10 am. We mark this solemn day with prayer and readings, kneeling in prayer before the cross.
- 8:00 p.m. **Easter Eve, April 23**
The Great Vigil of Easter begins at 8 pm as we light the new fire outside the church, move into the sanctuary bringing the new light, and then throw on the lights and sing the glory to God (don't forget to bring a bell!). We celebrate the new life of baptism, share communion, and rejoice that Christ is Risen!
